RULES AND REGULATIONS

While attending Adult Literacy Classes at Positive Growth Incorporated, the students will adhere to the following rules and regulations:

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1. Hazing involving students or property. Disposition is a formal hearing.
 2. Violation of federal, state, or local law on Positive Growth IEC premises or at center sponsored or supervised activities. Disposition is a formal hearing.
 3. Conduct that is unbecoming to a student, including but not limited to conduct that is disorderly, lewd, or indecent; a breach of peace; or aiding, abetting, or procuring another person to breach the peace on Positive Growth sponsored or participated b Incorporated premises or at other locations where classes, activities, or functions sponsored or participated by the center may be held. Disposition is a formal hearing.
 4. Use of tobacco products in center buildings except in marked designated smoking areas. Disposition is a formal hearing.
 5. Students shall not dress , groom, wear, or use emblems, insignias, badges, or other symbols or lewd or vulgar words where the effect thereof is offensive to a reasonable person or otherwise causes disruption or interference with the orderly operation of the center. Students shall at all times observe rules governing body cleanliness and not wear short or tight shorts, swimsuits, tank tops, bare midriff, or have bare feet. Disposition is a formal hearing.
 6. Firearms, explosives, fireworks, or weapons of any kind are not to be brought onto any campus premises or to center-sponsored events except as authorized by proper officials. Disposition is a formal hearing.
 7. The sale or attempted sale, use of or the perceived use of, or possession of any illegal, dangerous, or controlled drugs on any center premises or at any center-sponsored event is prohibited. Disposition is a formal hearing.
 8. The sale or attempted sale, use of or the perceived use of, or possession of alcoholic beverages on any center premises or at any campus-sponsored event is prohibited. Disposition is a formal hearing.
 9. No person shall abuse, threaten, or intimidate any member of the faculty, staff, student body, or any official visitor to Positive Growth Incorporated. Disposition is a formal hearing.
 10. There shall be NO cell phone usage during class time. If you must make/take a call please excuse yourself.
 11. If you have three consecutive absences from class without notifying the education director or coordinator you will be withdrawn from class!
 12. You are not allowed to spend time surfing the web (Facebook, Email, Twitter, Instagram, Youtube or any other social network)
 13. No person shall disturb another person with talking, eating, singing, music etc. You will be warned of any offense, after the 3rd offense you will be required to speak with the director.
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
