## Educational Classes

### GED Classes

#### Employment {2hrs once a week}

These classes will include

- Job Orientation
- On-the-Job Training
- Job Resources
- Educating them about the minimum wage, work compensation, employee rights
- **Internet classes (2 hrs per week).**

## Education/Support Groups

- Domestic Violence
- Substance Abuse
- Internet stress relief games
- Art Therapy
- Groups for women {trauma therapy}
- Anger Management
- Bulling and Gang prevention
- Assertiveness and decision making
- Financial Education
- Health Education

## Refugee Youth Programs

- After-school programs referrals
- Gang-prevention Classes

### Parent/School Involvement Services {2hrs a week}

These classes will help refugee parents to become actively involved in their children's education and will include:

- Parent education on the school system's policies and procedures **(individual and group)**
- Parent education regarding schools and educational terminology **(individual and group)**
- School-Related Casework to provide assistance to parents when they visit their children's schools **(individual)**

### Social Adjustment Services {2hrs once a week}

These classes and individual services will help refugees to adjust into their new lives in the U.S. and to encourage self-reliance to the point where the individual and/or family can successfully handle similar situations independently.

Included under this service are:

- Integration and Emotional Counseling **(individual and Group)**
- Home Management **(individual and group)**
- Emergency/Crisis Intervention {911, police, fire rescue and Ambulance} **(individual and group)**
- Physical and Mental health education **(individual and group)**

## Information and Referral Services

Classes to educate the refugees about the state and federal programs and community services (Food Stamps, Medicaid, WIC, energy assistance, low-income housing, childcare assistance).

Included under this service are:

- Case manager to refer them to these services
- Case managers to assist them with completing eligibility forms and applications.
